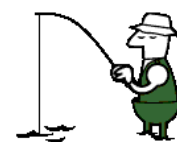
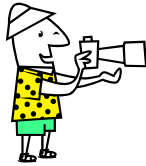
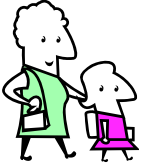


# Events—Our Fellowship in Action!

## How to get an event posted on the Region 5 'Events' page

It's easy to get an event posted on the Region 5 'Events Page'. That is the page on [www.region5oa.org](http://www.region5oa.org) that lists all of the events being sponsored by OA fellowships in Region 5. If you are an OA fellowship in Wisconsin, Northern Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Michigan, Southern Ontario or Kentucky, then your event qualifies.

There are two ways to get an event listed.

1. E-mail the essential information to Region 5 Web Headquarters at [website@region5oa.org](mailto:website@region5oa.org) to the attention of Leslie.

Essential information is:

- The name of the event.
- A brief description of the event, for instance a workshop, retreat, marathon, etc.
- The name of the sponsoring intergroup.
- The dates and times of the

event.

- The complete address where the event will be held (maybe some driving directions to the event).
- Cost or contribution information, if any. If its free, that's good to know too.
- Other important information you feel the attendees should know, for instance raffles, clothing exchanges, meal information, etc.

2. Send a copy of your flyer or brochure in pdf or MS Word format to [website@region5oa.org](mailto:website@region5oa.org) to the attention of Leslie.

It's important to keep in mind that Web Headquarters is not necessarily familiar with your intergroup. Most likely, you are sending an email to someone who has never, ever communicated with you before and has never been to your town.
